Department of Agriculture, Water and the Environment (DAWE) is undertaking an evaluation of the Farm Management Deposits Scheme (FMDS) to ensure it meets the expectations of primary producers, and operates efficiently.

Apart of this, they are running a public consultation process, and want to hear from primary producers. They are looking for feedback about:

- How the FMDS is run
- How it does/doesn't help producers manage through tough times
- Other ways primary producers manage risks and how these compare to the FMDS
